RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Kenneth Bates of Newburgh.

Kenneth Bates; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Kenneth Bates, of Newburgh, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Bates is 40 years old, served 4 years and 11 months in the 2nd World War and is now receiving \$17 per month pension. He has a peptic ulcer and does not feel able to work. He needs this pension for he does not have money enough now to buy the medication he needs.
