STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Merle Merrill of Liberty.

Merle Merrill; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$35 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Merle Merrill, of Liberty, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of chapter 94 of the resolves of 1953 which provides for a state pension for Merle Merrill, of Liberty, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Merle Merrill is 40 years of age and is unable to work sufficiently to support himself. His family has a very small income and are not financially able to support him. He is partly disabled but not enough to warrant coming under the new Aid to the Disabled.
