RESOLVE, Increasing State Pension for Lynwood R. Bowden of Penobscot.

Lynwood R. Bowden; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$45 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Lynwood R. Bowden, of Penobscot, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of chapter 94 of the resolves of 1953 which provides for a state pension for Lynwood R. Bowden, of Penobscot, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Bowden is around 40 years of age and partially paralyzed. He is unable to work and has no one to support him.
