AN ACT Authorizing Construction of a Breakwater Across Mill Cove, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Breakwater across entrance of Mill Cove, Crotch Island, Stonington Harbor, authorized. John L. Goss Corporation and Deer Isle Granite Corporation, both of Stonington, in the county of Hancock and State of Maine, their successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to extend and maintain the existing breakwater on Crotch Island in Stonington Harbor across the easterly end of Mill Cove, so called. Said extension shall begin on the southern end of the present breakwater which extends into the tidewaters from the property owned by Deer Isle Granite Corporation and run south for a distance of approximately 40 feet to the shore line of the John L. Goss Corporation property. It shall be constructed of grout and rubble granite and be of sufficient width for the safety and convenience of travel with necessary and convenient equipment in granite quarrying undertaking.
