STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize Construction and Maintenance of a Wharf in Long Lake at Naples by John Troup.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Wharf in Long Lake at Naples authorized. John Troup, his assigns, executors and heirs are hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a wharf opposite land owned by him in Long Lake in the town of Naples and to extend the same into said Long Lake for a distance of not more than 100 feet from the shore of the lake at low water mark.

No building shall be erected on said wharf and no part of the wharf shall extend above the level of the adjacent highway. There shall be an opening in the guard rail on the causeway to provide access to such wharf, which opening shall not exceed 10 feet in width. The wharf and approach shall not cover more than 1,000 square feet of area.

If the said wharf is not built before January 1, 1959, this act shall become void.
