IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Prohibiting the Use of Draggers in Part of Sheepscot Bay, Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 20, additional. Chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 29-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 29-A. Use of draggers in Sheepscot bay. It shall be unlawful to use a dragger or any other apparatus for the taking of fish or shellfish on the ocean bottom of that part of Sheepscot Bay, Sagadahoc county, from a point on the south end of Seguin to a point on the south end of Pumpkin Island.'
