STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Liability Policy for Applicants for Motor Vehicle Dealer or Transit Registration Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 29, sub-§ IV, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection IV of section 29 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 8 of chapter 200 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that the The Secretary of State shall not issue such registration until the applicant shall have procured and filed with the Secretary of State a certificate showing that the applicant is covered by a standard automobile garage liability policy, approved by the Insurance Commissioner, insuring against any legal liability in accordance with the terms of said policy for personal injury or death of any one person in the sum of \$10,000 and for any number of persons in the sum of \$20,000 and against property damage in the sum of \$5,000, which injury, death or damage may result from or have been caused by the operation of any motor vehicle bearing the registration of such dealer or such holder of a transit registration certificate.'
