RESOLVE, for Construction of Route No. 129 in Lincoln County.

Construction of Route No. 129; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 to be expended under the supervision of the State Highway Commission for the construction and repair of Route No. 129, beginning at intersection of Route No. 130 and continuing to Christmas Cove; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by this resolve shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The reasons for need for the construction and repair of Route No. 129 are:

- 1. To correct blind and very dangerous curves.
- 2. To eliminate blind elevations.
- 3. The economic livelihood of the entire town depends on this road.
- 4. There are 125 R. F. D. people served on this road.
- 5. Improvement imperative for the sake of highway safety.
- 6. Serves a summer population of approximately 5,000.
- 7. Serves Bristol Yacht Building Company.
