AN ACT Relating to Claims Against the State for Taxes Lost to Municipalities by Exemptions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ II, ¶ J, additional. Subsection II of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered J, to read as follows:

‘J. Any municipality granting exemptions under the provisions of this subsection shall have a valid claim against the State to recover 70% of the taxes lost by reason of such exemptions as exceeds 3% of the total local tax levy, upon proof of the facts in form satisfactory to the Commissioner of Finance and Administration. Such claims shall be presented to the Legislature next convening.’
