STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Limitation of Financial Responsibility Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 77, sub-§ V, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection V of section 77 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'B. To either the owner or licensed operator of a motor vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer involved in an accident when the Secretary shall be satisfied that neither such owner nor operator caused the accident the motor vehicle was in a lawfully parked position or stopped at a stop sign, yield the right of way sign, traffic signal, or at the direction of a police officer or constable, or that said motor vehicle has been brought to a halt because of an emergency;'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 77, sub-§ V, ¶ D, repealed. Paragraph D of subsection V of section 77 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:
 - 'D. To either the owner or operator of a motor vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer involved in an accident where no damage or injury was eaused to other than the person or property of such owner or operator, unless at the time of said accident such owner or operator was violating some provision of the state laws relative to motor vehicles.'
