HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 340, L. D. 919, Bill, "An Act Relating to Area Directional Signs on Turnpikes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 152" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 152. Area directional signs on turnpikes. In order to guide the users of the State Turnpike System to those exits leading to the recreational areas of the State situate near the Turnpike, the Maine Turnpike Authority shall erect and maintain over or beside the lanes of traffic approaching each appropriate exit descriptive and directional signs suitably designating the area. The copy on each sign erected under this section shall be plainly legible at a distance of 300 feet when traveling at the maximum lawful speed. The location and copy of each sign shall be determined by the Maine Turnpike Authority after consultation with representatives of the recreational area. The Maine Turnpike Authority, in the absence of a specific recreational area, situate near an exit, may erect suitable signs and copy at the exit designating motel, hotel and restaurant areas.
