HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 340, L. D. 919,
Bill, "An Act Relating to Area Directional Signs on Turnpikes."

Amend said Amendment by adding at the end of that part designated
"Sec. 149-A" a new paragraph to read as follows:

'In the absence of a specific recreational area, the State High-
way Commission on the state constructed and maintained interstate
system and the Maine Turnpike Authority on the highways constructed
by said Authority may erect, situated near an exit, suitable signs
at the exit designating motel, hotel and restaurant areas.'
