SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 352, L.D. 930, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Weight of Commercial Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, the following:

"Sec. 3. R. S., c. 22, §36, amended. The 1st paragraph of
section 36 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by
chapter 18 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to
read as follows:

'No person shall operate, or cause to be operated, any truck,
tractor, trailer or combination of truck tractor and semi-trailer,
with a gross weight that is more than 10% above that specified in
the registration certificate for such vehicle for trucks of gross
weight of not over 15,000 pounds and 5% for trucks of gross weight
of over 15,000 pounds; provided, however, that no motor vehicle of
either a single unit or combined unit shall be operated on the
highway with a gross weight that exceeds ~~50,000~~ 60,000 pounds.' "
