STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Excluding Federal Aid as an Incidental Receipt in State Subsidy Allocation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 237, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 237 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Except as above provided for the fiscal years beginning July 4, 1955, and July 4, 1956, for For each classification the subsidy allocation shall be the same for each of the 2 years of the biennium and shall be a percentage of the average educational costs of the municipality for the preceding 2 years, excluding costs of capital outlay, rent, debt service, repairs and certain equipment, and deducting incidental receipts, except that federal aid shall not be considered as an incidental receipt.'
