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### AN ACT Relating to Weekly Benefits for Total Unemployment Under Employment Security Law.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 13, sub-§ II, repealed and replaced.** Subsection II of section 13 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 367 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**'II. Weekly benefit amount for total unemployment. On or after April 1, 1957, each individual who is totally unemployed in any week shall be paid with respect to such week benefits of 1/13th of 59% of his annual wage or salary up to and including \$4,200 for a period of 26 weeks during one year.'**
