## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to Definition of Wages Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 29, § 3, sub-§ XIX, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection XIX of section 3 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 'A. Subsequent to December 31, 1950, that part of remuneration which after remuneration equal to \$3,000 \$4,200 has been paid in a calendar year to an individual by an employer or his predecessor with respect to employment during any calendar year, is paid to such individual by such employer during such calendar year unless that part of the remuneration is subject to a tax under a federal law imposing a tax against which credit may be taken for contributions required to be paid into a state unemployment fund. The wages of an individual for employment with an employer shall be subject to this exception whether earned in this State or any other state when the employer employee relationship is between the same legal entities.'
