## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Disposal of Fees Paid to City or Town Clerks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91, § 28, amended. Section 28 of chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 307 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof, a new paragraph, as follows:

'All fees of clerks in municipalities of over 3,000 inhabitants shall be paid into the treasury of the municipality and said clerk shall receive a salary in lieu of all of the fees of his office.'
