Amend said Amendment by striking out the single quotation mark
at the end and inserting in place thereof the following underlined
sentence:

"The provisions of this section shall not apply to the Maryland
hydraulic clam dredge or the Long Island hydraulic clam dredge,
provided no marine worms taken by these machines shall be marketed
in any form or manner."
