SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 689, L. D. 957, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Methods of Taking Clams and Marine Worms."

Amend said Bill by striking out the single quotation mark at
the end thereof and inserting at the end thereof the following under-
lined sentence:

'The provisions of this section shall not apply to any Maryland type
dredge operated solely within the limits of Hancock county, provided
permission to operate such dredge shall be obtained from the municipal
officers of the municipality wherein such dredge is operated.'
