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**AN ACT Relating to Definition of Out-of-state Service Under State Retirement System.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 63-A, § 1, amended.** The 12th paragraph of section 1 of chapter 63-A, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Out-of-state service” shall mean service rendered as an employee of any state of the United States, except Maine, or of any political subdivision of any such state or of any country occupied by the United States.’
