RESOLVE, Relating to Moneys to Obtain Plasma.

Resolves, 1951, c. 137, amended. Resolved: That Chapter 137 of the Resolves of 1951 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Plasma; appropriating moneys to obtain. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$15,375 for the purpose of supplying materials in connection with the accumulation, storage and maintenance of 5,000 units of liquid plasma and 500 units of dried plasma to be available in the event of a disaster; this money to be expended upon authorization by the department of health and welfare. ~~Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account~~'
