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**AN ACT Relating to Adjustment of Losses by Certain Nonresident Insurance Adjusters.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 60, § 297, amended.** Section 297 of chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, as follows:

‘The Commissioner may waive the provisions of this section for a period of not to exceed 90 consecutive days whenever a catastrophe or other emergency condition arising in this State makes it necessary, in his opinion, for adjusters duly licensed in other states to enter this State to assist in the adjustment of losses.’
