RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Franklin.

Town of Franklin; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$156.03 to be paid to the town of Franklin to reimburse it for aid given to Lester G. Foss and family, state paupers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lester Foss and family moved to Franklin. The town of Franklin furnished them with supplies and have been unable to collect from the town of Wesley where the family formerly lived. Mr. Foss has no settlement in any town in the State of Maine. The town of Franklin can not afford to support this family.
