STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Philip Krisilos, of Portland.

Philip Krisilos; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$90.46 to be paid to Philip Krisilos, of Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his restaurant, the Anchor Lunch, by escapees from the State School for Boys.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On the twenty-first day of September, 1955, certain escapees from the State School for Boys in South Portland, Maine, did break into the restaurant known as the Anchor Lunch at 15 Portland Pier, Portland, Maine, operated by Philip Krisilos. The escapees did damage and stole goods in the amount of \$90.46.
