**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Mercer for Supplies Furnished
Orlando Hunnewell.**

Town of Mercier; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$95.63 to be paid to the town of Mercer to reimburse it for supplies furnished to Orlando Hunnewell.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This claim represents a series of purchases made as far back as 1952 and 1953. The recent charges for the months of October and November are not too delinquent but the other charges were not filed in time with the Department of Health and Welfare.
