RESOLVE, Opening Chub Pond, Somerset County, to Ice Fishing.

Chub pond; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Chub pond, T4, R6, Somerset county, to ice fishing for all fish except trout, salmon and togue.
