COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 369, L. D. 992, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Persons Qualified to Serve as Jurors."

Amend said Bill by striking out all thereof after the enacting  
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R.S., c. 116, §4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 116 of the  
Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a  
new sentence, to read as follows:

'No person shall be qualified or selected for jury service who has  
served as such at any term of the Superior Court held within 3 years  
next preceeding the re-selection of said person by the jury com-  
missioners.'"
