IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Persons Qualified to Serve as Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 116, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence thereof, a new sentence, as follows:

'No person shall be qualified for jury service who has served as juror within 5 years preceding such selection.'
