STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing a Uniform Date for City and Town Caucuses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 4, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence: Each town committee shall hold a caucus on the last Monday of February in the year in which a convention is called pursuant to section 16 for the election of officers and delegates to the state convention.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 4, § 12, amended. Section 12 of chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 343 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 12. Exceptions. The provisions of the 9 preceding sections 1 to 7, inclusive, and sections 9 to 11, inclusive, shall not apply to towns or cities wherein the calling and holding of caucuses is regulated by special law.'
