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### **AN ACT Relating to Definition of Fiduciary Under Law Appointing Nominees by Banking Institutions.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 59, § 246, amended.** Section 246 of chapter 59 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 90 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

**'The term "fiduciary" as used in this section shall include, but shall not be limited to, executors, administrators, guardians, conservators, trustees, agents, custodians and each of them.'**
