SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 373, L. D. 996, Resolve, Authorizing
Department of Inland Fisheries and Game to Acquire
Certain Lands and Water Rights in Town of Pembroke.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the Title and before
the Headnote the following Emergency Preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed by
the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjourn-
ment; and

Whereas, to enable the Department of Inland Fisheries and
Game this spring to develop fish and game resources by using certain
lands and water rights in Washington County, it is necessary that
this resolve become effective immediately; and

Whereas, this resolve is necessary to conserve certain of our
natural resources; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create
an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and re-
quire the following legislation as immediately necessary for the pre-
servation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be
it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end thereof, be-
fore the Statement of Facts, the following Emergency Clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
