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### STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED  
FIFTY-SEVEN

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**RESOLVE, Authorizing Department of Inland Fisheries and Game to Acquire  
Certain Lands and Water Rights in Town of Pembroke.**

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**Department of Inland Fisheries and Game; authorized. Resolved:** That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized to accept in the name of the State of Maine and without cost to the State of Maine a quitclaim deed to the water rights and the two dams on the Pennamaquan river in the town of Pembroke, county of Washington, for the purpose of using these facilities for purposes of developing fish and game resources; and be it further

**Resolved:** That the State of Maine, in accepting this property, agrees not to use the facilities for power generating purposes.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Each of the dams were used for power generating purposes and have been abandoned.
