STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Provide Funds for Matching Federal Funds for Training in Fisheries Trades.

Matching funds; appropriated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 and \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959 to match federal funds allocated to Maine under P. L. 1027, 84th Congress to establish vocational education training in the fisheries trades.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Federal funds are available to establish vocational education training in the fisheries trades. This resolve is for the purpose of matching these federal funds.
