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

## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE to Reimburse Town of Chapman for Supplies Furnished Sherman McGlinchey.

Town of Chapman; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$1,422.38 to be paid to the town of Chapman to reimburse it for aid given to Sherman McGlinchey.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The past 2 years the appropriation for the support of the poor and aid to dependent children has been over 10% of total appropriations.

Mr. McGlinchey has had help from the town from time to time in the past. A year ago he was taken sick and was taken to the hospital but never fully recovered from his sickness. He is at Willow Crest Home, Inc., in Gardiner, Maine, with a cost to the town of \$20 per week plus medical care.
