IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Chapman for Supplies Furnished George Henderson.

Town of Chapman; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$1,485.80 to be paid to the town of Chapman to reimburse it for aid given to George Henderson.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The appropriation in the town of Chapman for the past 2 years for support of the poor and aid to dependent children has been over 10% of the total appropriation.

Mr. Henderson received Old Age Assistance until a few years ago when he was denied such aid.
