# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Town Budgets for Educational Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 91, § 101-A, additional.** Chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 101-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 101-A. Appropriations for educational purposes. Whenever any state law or rule and regulation to the Department of Education requires a town to expend more than 65% of its annual budget for educational purposes, excluding any state subsidy, the State shall reimburse said town for any excess over said 65%.'
