### AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Deer in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended.** The 1st paragraph of section 91 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘There shall be an annual open season on deer during the month of November in each calendar year in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Sagadahoc, Waldo ~~Washington~~ and York. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.’

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended.** Section 91 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by inserting after the 2nd paragraph thereof, a new paragraph, as follows:

‘There shall be an open season on deer in each calendar year beginning the 20th day of October and ending the 15th day of November, both dates inclusive, in the county of Washington. All the rest of the calendar year, either before or after the open season, shall be a closed season on deer in Washington county.’
