STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Dumping Rubbish and Bottles on Highways from Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 137, § 31, amended. Section 31 of chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 206 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 31. Throwing of bottles, etc., on highways. Whoever throws or deposits on any public way or on land within the bounds of such way or property adjacent thereto any bottles or metal cans, except in proper containers placed for rubbish collection and removal, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 \$100. If such throwing or depositing was done from a motor vehicle, it shall be prima facie evidence that the throwing or depositing was by the driver of the motor vehicle.'
