STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Beano.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 139, § 23, amended. The 1st sentence of section 23 of chapter 139 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Chief of the State Police may issue licenses to operate such amusement for a period of 6 days to any fair association or bona fide charitable, educational, fraternal, patriotic, religious or veterans organization which was in existence at least 2 years prior to its application for a license, when sponsored, operated and conducted for the exclusive benefit of such organization, except for operating costs, by duly authorized members thereof; provided that said. Said 2 years years' limitation shall not apply to any chartered posts of veterans organizations, nationally established, even though such posts have not been in existence for 2 years prior to their application for a license.'
