IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor by Hotels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 41-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 41-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 41-A. Hotel licensees. Hotels, having a license for the sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises, may serve persons who remain standing at the bar.'
