# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to Sunday Sale of Liquor in Hotels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, § 27, amended. The 2nd sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 27 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No licensee shall permit the consumption of liquors on his premises on Sundays of after 15 minutes past the hours prohibited for sale thereof, except by bona fide guests in their rooms.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 61, § 27, amended. Section 27 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 71 of the public laws of 1955 and by section 4-A of chapter 355 of the public laws of 1955 and by section 2 of chapter 403 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence thereof, a new sentence, to read as follows:

'No licensee shall permit the consumption of liquors on his premises on Sundays, except that a hotel licensee may make sales and permit consumption of liquors on Sundays between the hours of 1:00 P. M. to 11:00 P. M. to bona fide guests with meals in the dining room or in the rooms of the guests.'
