AN ACT Relating to Sunday Sale of Liquor in Hotels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, § 27, amended. The 2nd sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 27 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No licensee shall permit the consumption of liquors on his premises ~~on Sundays~~ ~~or~~ after 15 minutes past the hours prohibited for sale thereof, except by bona fide guests in their rooms.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 61, § 27, amended. Section 27 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 71 of the public laws of 1955 and by section 4-A of chapter 355 of the public laws of 1955 and by section 2 of chapter 403 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence thereof, a new sentence, to read as follows:

'No licensee shall permit the consumption of liquors on his premises on Sundays, except that a hotel licensee may make sales and permit consumption of liquors on Sundays between the hours of 1:00 P. M. to 11:00 P. M. to bona fide guests with meals in the dining room or in the rooms of the guests.'
