RESOLVE, Authorizing the Study of Feasibility of Creating Sugarloaf National Park.

Sugarloaf National Park; feasibility of creating. Resolved: That the Governor be, and hereby is, authorized to appoint a committee of 3 or 5 persons to investigate and study the feasibility of cooperating in the creation of the "Sugarloaf National Park" to be located south of Flagstaff Lake and include Mt. Bigelow Range, Sugarloaf Mountain, Crocker Mountain, Mt. Abraham and Saddleback Mountain with due consideration to the franchise and lease rights of the "Sugarloaf Mountain Corporation," and to report its findings to the Governor as soon as possible.
