**RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Viola Michaud of
Soldier Pond.**

Viola Michaud; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Viola Michaud, of Soldier Pond, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

That part of chapter 167 of the resolves of 1951 which provides for a state pension for Viola Michaud is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Viola Michaud is 54 years of age and has the mentality of a six year old. She cannot receive Aid to Disabled as she is healthy and is not physically disabled. She now resides with a sister. The town of Eagle Lake has been giving her aid but has discontinued it because a case like this could go on for years.
