STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of Deputies by County Sheriff.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 151, amended. The 1st sentence of section 151 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every sheriff, elected or appointed, may appoint deputies one deputy for every 2,000 inhabitants of his county for whose official misconduct and neglect he is answerable.'
