IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Regulating Motor Vehicles at Traffic Circles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 86-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 86-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 86-A. Right of way at traffic circles. The driver of any vehicle, approaching but not having entered a traffic circle, shall yield the right of way to a vehicle already within such traffic circle.'
