STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Martha Jewett of Wilton.

Martha Jewett; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Martha Jewett, of Wilton, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Jewett owns a small home in East Wilton where she is now residing. She earned her own living until $1\frac{1}{2}$ years ago when she had a shock and is now unable to work. She is 73 years of age and has no income. She is a great granddaughter of a Revolutionary War soldier.
