STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire for Livermore Falls Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1899, c. 120, § 13, amended. The last sentence of section 13 of chapter 120 of the private and special laws of 1899, as last amended by chapter 117 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of \$1,400 in full for all services, payable weekly from the treasury of Androscoggin county, and an additional sum of \$1,000 for clerk hire.'
