STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Pasteurized Milk Only to Certain Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 113-A, additional. Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 113-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 113-A. Pasteurized milk only to certain institutions. Pasteurized milk only shall be sold to the State, any public hospital, any school lunch program, or any charitable or educational institution which is supported in whole or in part by aid granted by the State or any municipality.'
