HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 740, L. D. 1054, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Application and Qualification for Real Estate Brokers'
Licenses."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last 3 lines of section
1, and inserting in place thereof the following: 'of age or over.
Every applicant for a license as a broker shall have first served
a bona fide apprenticeship for a period of one year as a duly
licensed real estate salesman in this state, or in the discretion
of the commission, by furnishing to the commission proof of ex-
perience equivalent thereto, or by furnishing to the commission
a certificate that said applicant has passed a real estate course
of study at an accredited college or university.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2
thereof.

Further amend said Bill by striking out immediately after the
enacting clause, the phrase "Sec. 1".
